Guidelines for Scholarship Awards



Purpose

To provide scholarships

- to help people attain an education in the health care field
- to alleviate the local shortage of personnel in the health care professions
- to qualifying persons for education and leadership development in health care careers

How to obtain an application:

- request via email to office@firstpresnampa.org
- download from website www.firstpresnampa.org
- contact First United Presbyterian Church office at 208-466-7061
- financial aid departments at institutions of higher education in Idaho

Application deadlines:

- Postmarked by March 15th for the following school year. Scholarship will be awarded after April 15th.
- Postmarked by September 30th for the spring semester. Scholarship will be awarded after October 31st.

What to include:

- Application
- Statement of intent to practice in the Treasure Valley
- Confirmation of enrollment in an accredited educational program that leads to a career in health care. (If classes in which you are currently enrolled appear on your transcript, then separate documentation is not needed.)
- Documentation of financial need – Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) will be one consideration for funding as verified through your submitted FAFSA
- Two letters of recommendation
 - One from an educator
 - One from a business or professional associate
- Official transcripts(s) of educational credits

Additional information regarding scholarships:

- Applications will be considered by the HELP Scholarship Committee who will recommend recipients to HELP Board. A vote of the membership will determine the recipient(s).
- The standard scholarship amounts awarded will be determined by the HELP Board based on available funds.
- GPA and financial need are considered when awarding scholarships.
- Preference will be given to students currently enrolled accredited healthcare programs.
- It is expected that the student is in good standing at the time of application.
- Certificates will be presented to the recipient(s) documenting the award.
- Funds will be dispersed to the educational institution in which the recipient is enrolled.
- Recipients may receive an award in successive years not to exceed three years.
- Recipients are expected to inform the HELP Board regarding progress in their educational program. A written report is due by January 15 of the school year for which they have received the scholarship.
